Making sure all shifts are covered every day from sunup to sundown is extremely important to the district's responsibility of protecting resources in the State Ecological Reserve and the County Multi-Use Area and was necessary in allowing District staff valuable time with families during the holidays.

Steve is also one of the most active volunteers for the Santa Rosa Plateau Nature Education Foundation (SRPNEF). He is the point person for all special event set-up and break-down duties. ### **Brandon Munoz**


Brandon Munoz is our Shining Star by his Outstanding Service (he goes to infinity and beyond for our customers, and colleagues).
